Enhancing UDS Data through UDS+

UDS Legacy

The Uniform Data System (UDS) is a standard data set reported annually and provides consistent information about health centers, including:

- Patient characteristics
- Services provided
- Clinical processes
- Health outcomes
- Patients' use of services
- Staffing
- Costs and revenues



HRSA

Health center level data is collected and sent to HRSA.

UDS+

UDS+ is the electronic submission of de-identified patient-level data using Fast Healthcare Interoperability Resources (FHIR) with the goals of:

- Reducing Reporting Burden
- Better Measuring Impact
- Promoting Transparency



HRSA

Patient level data is sent to HRSA.

What is UDS Patient Level Submission (UDS+)?

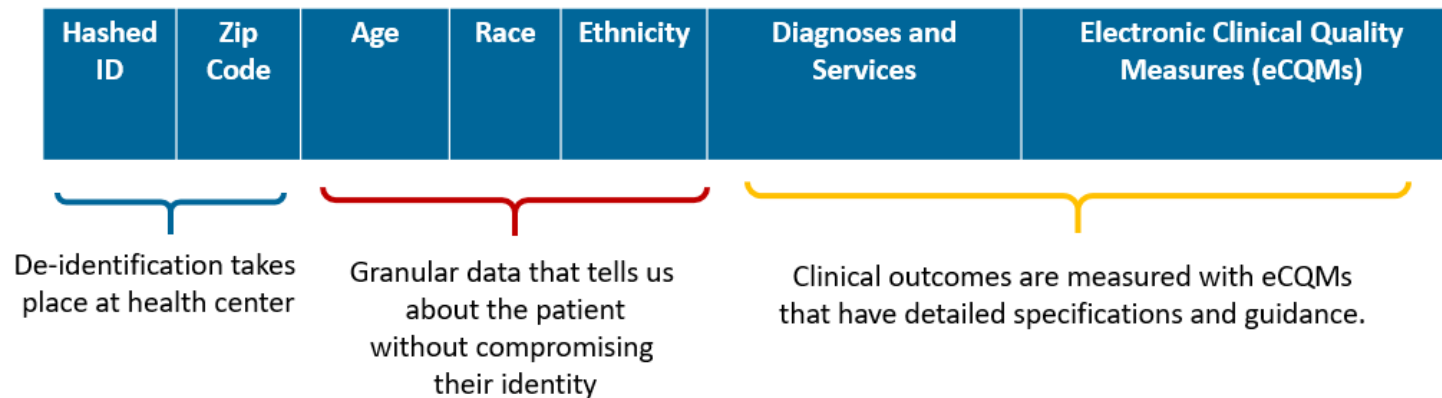
UDS+ is...

- Beginning with CY 2023 UDS (data submitted in 2024), BPHC will accept patient-level report data.
 - UDS Tables Patients by ZIP Code, 3A, 3B, 4, 6A, 6B, and 7
- Submitted **electronically** via Fast Healthcare Interoperability Resources (FHIR)

UDS+ does not...

- Collect full copies of data directly from patients' electronic medical records.
- Collect patient identifiers.

Understand and communicate the **unique characteristics and needs** of health center patients



Improve **preparedness** for public health emergencies



Illustrate the **breadth and depth** of **health center services** and their **impact** on health outcomes



Provide **evidence for aligned reimbursements** for care provided



Inform **training, technical assistance** and **research and evaluation**



Align with national interoperability standards to support health center ability to engage in future-state, integrated health care models



UDS+ 2024 Reporting Requirements & the UTC

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UDS+ 2024 Reporting Year: Submission Requirements



2024 UDS+ Submissions
Due by **May 30, 2025**

- 1 Submit data for your **medical** patients
- 2 Submit **all** the demographic tables data
 - **Table:** Patients by ZIP Code
 - **Table 3A:** Patients by Age and by Sex
 - **Table 3B:** Demographic Characteristics
 - Updates to align to Executive Orders
 - **Table 4:** Selected Patient Characteristics

(Managed Care Utilization lines are NOT required for UDS+ CY 2024 reporting)

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Submit **1 eCQM** from the measures listed below:

- **Table 6B:** Quality of Care Measures
 - Breast Cancer Screening
 - Cervical Cancer Screening
 - Colorectal Cancer Screening
- **Table 7:** Health Outcomes and Disparities
 - **Controlling High Blood Pressure***
 - Diabetes: Hemoglobin A1c (HbA1c) Poor Control (>9.0%)

6.1 Change History

The following is a list of all the changes based on versions.

6.1.1 Changes made from 1.1.0 to 2.0.0

1. Added validations for ensuring dates are in the range between 1900 and 2030
2. Added validations for postalCode to ensure only digits are supported for both regular and extended format.
3. Added validations for Age to be > 0
4. Aligned Birth Sex value set with US Core Birth Sex value set
5. Allowed for null flavors in Coverage.type value set
6. Added validations for income observations to ensure data is represented as per the specification
7. Added example for income observation with only Range.high values

6.1.2 Changes made from 1.0.0 to 1.1.0

1. Added support for Partial Submissions supporting Health Centers with multiple EHRs and/or multiple reporting sites.

2024 Calendar Year: UDS & UDS+ Reporting

All health centers were **required** to submit **aggregated** UDS data by **February 15, 2025**.

All health centers will be required to submit a minimum amount of **patient-level data (UDS+)** by **May 30, 2025**.



- Submit aggregated UDS data through EHBs, using the traditional submission method.
- Include all UDS tables and appendices.
- This will be the official submission of record.



- Submit UDS+ data via FHIR.
- Include, at a minimum, only demographic data and 1 eCQM for medical patients.
- UDS+ submission supports system capacity building and progress towards full implementation.

EHBs will remain the submission of record.

Submission and Communication: Legacy UDS vs UDS+

Legacy UDS Submission

- Submitted via Electronic Handbooks (EHBs) by February 15, 2025
- Manual data entry and submission
- Health center staff are primary contact for issues with submission
- Communications about submission occur via EHBs

UDS+ Submission

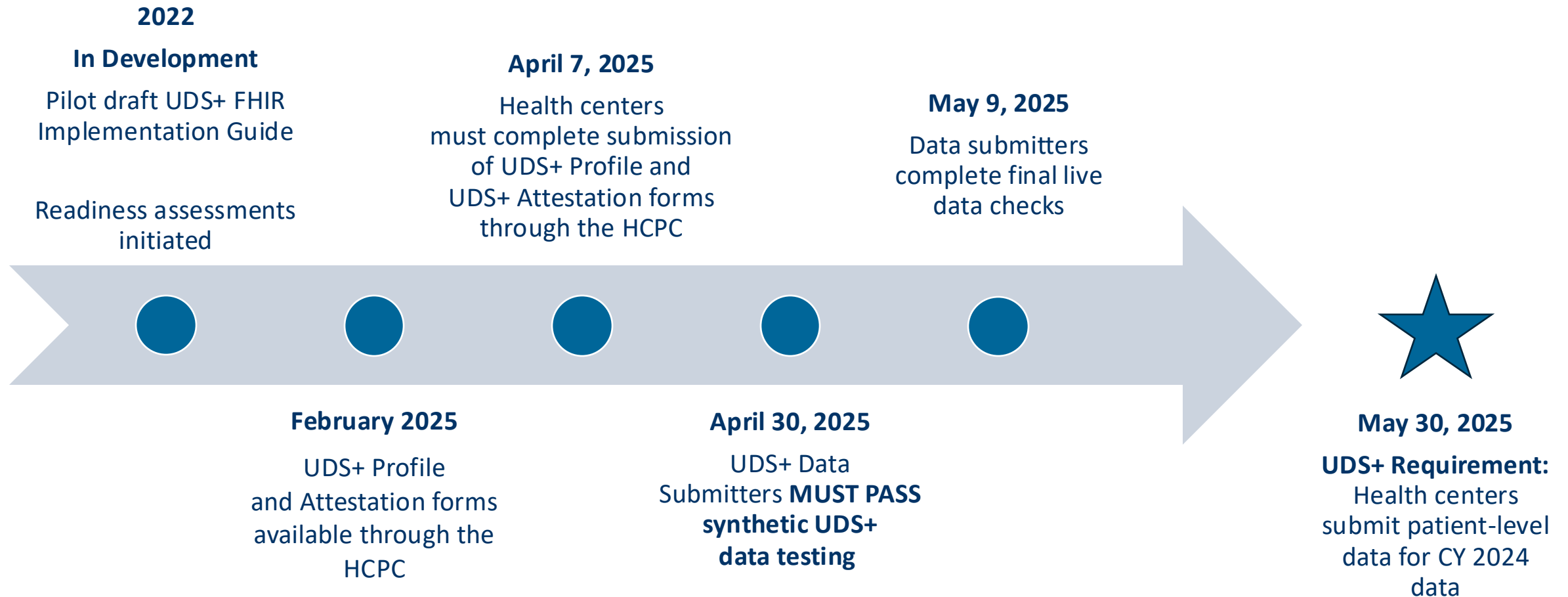
- Data submitted via a FHIR API to HRSA by **May 30, 2025**
- Automated data submission
- If vendor supported, the HIT vendor and health center will be primary contact for issues with submission
- Communications about submission occur via Salesforce
 - Including Profile and Attestation

UDS+ Readiness Timeline

- UDS+ Profile and Attestation- Submission by **April 7, 2025**
- All UDS+ Data Submitters **MUST PASS synthetic UDS+ data testing** to submit UDS+ CY24. Synthetic UDS+ testing for CY24 must be completed by **April 30, 2025**
- Deadline for UDS+ Data Submitters to complete final live data checks: **May 9, 2025**
- Deadline for UDS+ CY24 submissions: **May 30, 2025**

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UDS+ Profile and Attestation Forms

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Salesforce UDS+ Profile and Attestation Forms

- **All health centers** must submit a UDS+ Profile and Attestation form via Salesforce prior to the CY2024 UDS+ Submission
- **Purpose** of these forms are to:
 - Confirm health center contact information
 - Communicate with data submitters and connect health centers

UDS+ Profile and Attestation Process

- Profile forms will be pre-populated with your health center's information but must be confirmed
 - **Profile form includes:**
 - Health Center Name
 - Address
 - UDS+ Points of Contact
 - Grant Number
 - UEI
 - Production Client ID

UDS+ Profile and Attestation Process

- Attestation form includes:
 - HIT vendor/ UDS+ Data Submitter selection
 - Data that will be submitted
 - Medical patients (Minimum)
 - All patients (Optional)
 - Submission of data
 - Full calendar year
 - Part of the calendar year (for those transitioning EHR systems)
 - Free text field to provide additional detail as needed

HIT Vendor Readiness Steps for UDS+ Submission to HRSA

Step 1	Submission of a completed UDS+ Testing form and readiness to support a health center's submission of UDS+ data.
Step 2	Confirm UDS+ profile and connectivity to HRSA environment.
Step 3	Onboarding to the HRSA Sandbox and the beginning of testing.
Step 4	Successful completion of testing, including completing checks to prevent the submission of protected health information (PHI), resulting in availability to be listed as a Data Submitter. Once an HIT vendor has passed this step, they are ready to submit UDS+ data on behalf of their Health Centers.

If you utilize Cerner as an HIT vendor, typically CommunityWorks (products including Millenium, PowerChart, P2 Sentinel, etc), please note that Cerner is not currently testing/supporting UDS+ CY24 submissions (Reporting Year 2025). Cerner advises clients connect with their Oracle representation (Client Accountability Executive (CAE)) to discuss the situation. Guidance will be provided from the Cerner UDS+ team, after investigation into each Cerner clients's unique IT situation, regarding best practice suggestion for UDS+ submission by the deadline.
